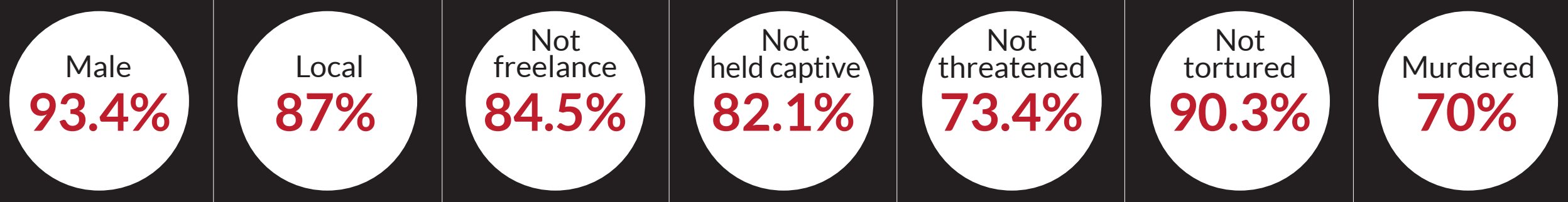
5 MOST DANGEROUS COUNTRIES FOR MEDIA WORKERS

Iraq, the Philippines, Russia, Colombia and Mexico had the most media worker deaths from 1992 to 2011. The United States tied with Belarus and the Ivory Coast for 25th most dangerous country with 6 deaths each. Press freedom status is listed beside the total deaths under each country's name. The deaths are broken into percentages of the categories describing the journalists and the experience leading to their deaths. For some of the journalists the information is unknown.



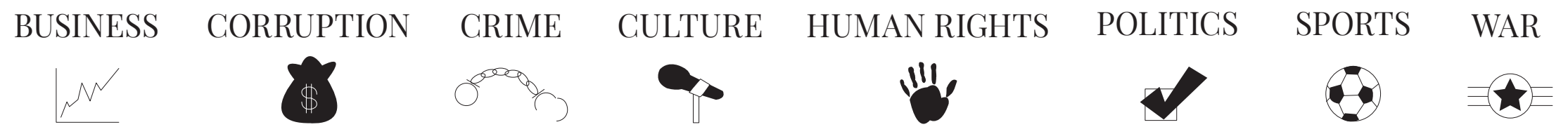
THE TOTALS
